## NOTES RELATING TO COMPLETION OF APPLICATION FORM

- 1. Application for Special Event Licence must be submitted at least 30 days prior to the date of the event.
- 2. A fee of €25.00 per event shall be made payable to Kilkenny Council in respect of an application for a Special Event Licence.
- All applications for a Special Event Licence must be accompanied with evidence of Public Liability Insurance indemnifying Kilkenny Council in the sum of not less than €6.4 million.
- 4. Applications for a Special Event Licence relating to the sale of food must be accompanied with a copy of a Food Staff Licence from the Health Service Executive.
- 5. If the 'event' is being held on private property the application must be accompanied with the written consent of the landowner.

## **NOTE (For Information Only)**

Section 4(11) of the Casual Trading Act, 1995, provides that the Local Authority concerned shall notify the Minister for Social Welfare of the name and address of a person to whom a Casual Trading Licence is granted and the conditions of the licence and Section 4(2A) of the Casual Trading Act, 1995 (inserted by section 141 of the Finance Act, 1996 (No. 9 of 1996)) provides that the local authority concerned shall notify the Revenue Commissioners of the name, address and tax reference number of a person to whom a casual trading licence was granted and the conditions of the licence. Section 13 of the Casual Trading Act, 1995, also provides that a local authority may establish and maintain the Register of Casual Trading Licences on computer. In such circumstances, personal data kept in the register is subject to the requirements of the Data Protection Act, 1988 (No. 25 of 1988) including an individual's right of access to and verification of data, where appropriate.
