BACKGROUND

The Solicitor for the Brennans' contacted Kilkenny County Council to request a rectification of their Client's title, when it was noted that the side garden of their dwelling was still registered to Kilkenny County Council even though the dwelling was purchased outright from Kilkenny County Council in 1999 under the Tenant Purchase Scheme of that time. Mr. Brennan's late family have been in occupation of the dwelling and possession of this garden since the mid 1950's. The Council has never exercised possession of the lands since this time and as the lands have always been in the possession of the Brennan family, the Transfer of the lands in order to correct the Brennan's title, is being recommended at this time.
