The Unlucky Cabin Boy is a new musical devised by Gúna Nua Theatre Company in conjunction with playwright Mike Finn and The Brad Pitt Light Orchestra. Based on a true story, The Unlucky Cabin Boy tells of the young Patrick O'Brien of Limerick in 1835. In a desperate attempt to escape his life of poverty, he signed himself aboard the Francis Spaight ship as a cabin boy on the ship's voyage to the New World. On the ship's return from St. John, New Brunswick, the Frances Spaight encountered a terrible storm and capsized. With several crew members drowned, the remaining sailors were able to right the ship by cutting the mast leaving them utterly stranded in the vast ocean; their provisions, water and possessions having been lost overboard.


Harald Ossberger




