32% of all Kilkenny students enrolled in third level are attending SETU. The number of Kilkenny students enrolled in SETU is more than double the number enrolled in any other third level institution. The institution with the second highest enrollment from Kilkenny students is UCC at 13%.

Ambassador Book Launch

LEO Jobs Growth 2025

The Local Enterprise Office (LEO) Kilkenny is now financially supporting 192 small businesses, which together employ 1,119 people.

Nationally, the LEO network reported its highest employment levels since its inception, with 40,285 jobs now supported across 7,148 client companies. Across Ireland, LEO-supported businesses created 7,261 new jobs in 2025, representing a 7% increase on 2024 and marking the 12th consecutive year of jobs growth. 82% of all new jobs created by LEO clients in 2025 were outside Dublin

Planning/Multi-Unit Developments January 2026

83 multi-unit housing developments with planning permission secured in County Kilkenny/ **35** of these within Kilkenny city, **29** of these in larger county towns. **2,848** units within the **83** schemes in the county & city. **562** units built in total in County Kilkenny with **451** units under construction. Of these there are **437** units built within Kilkenny city with **183** units under construction. An additional **22** multi-unit development applications are in the the planning system currently.
