## Register for the reduced fee of €5 before 28th September

The Water Services (Amendment) Act 2012 introduces a new registration and inspection system for septic tanks and other domestic wastewater treatment systems.

## Who is liable?

If you own a property connected to a septic tank or another domestic wastewater treatment system you need to register your system by 1st February 2013. The registration fee is only  $\in$ 5 until 28th September this year. It will increase to  $\in$ 50 after that date. It is a one-off fee. Risk-based inspections will commence in 2013. You will not receive an invoice.
