What can I learn from this leaflet?

This leaflet was compiled by Kilkenny County Council's Climate Action Office. The aim is to provide information on how climate action can be undertaken at local level into the grants listed within.

Climate action means making changes big and small to slow down global warming and keep people and nature safe for the future. This includes reducing energy use, and using clean renewable energy sources i.e. wind and solar, reducing pollution by using sustainable transport, planting trees and protecting biodiversity. Hints & Tips

Energy

- Aim to reduce energy use in community buildings, home and workplace by installing energy efficient lighting and heating.
- Consider installing energy saving initiatives and invest in renewable energy sources.
- If you are embarking on a project is your contractor using sustainable products that have a reduced environmental impact?



Waste

- Can you recycle your waste (food waste to garden compost).
- Donate your unwanted items to a new home (i.e community library, charity shop)



Travel

- Consider using public transport, car-pooling with neighbours or can you travel by bike or walk instead? These changes can have positive effects on your personal health, result in less pollution and reduces reliance on fossil fuels.
- If buying goods or services, please try and shop local to cut down on unnecessary carbon emissions.

Water

- Install a water refill station in your local area which will reduce using single use plastic bottles and reduce littering.
- Install a rainwater harvesting butt in your garden or at your local community building to use in your garden during dry weather and for car washing.



Food

- Start growing some of your own food or source your food from local, sustainable suppliers.
- Can you choose a plant based food option?

Biodiversity

- Introduce an area in your garden, workplace or community as a pollinator friendly area.
- Create a biodiversity trail or plant native hedging and trees which will provide a natural habitat for wildlife and sequester carbon. <https://biodiversityireland.ie/>

Art materials

- Choose art materials made from natural pigments, organic ingredients, and biodegradable materials and buy local. Incorporate recycled paper, reclaimed wood, and found objects into your artwork. Be responsible and properly dispose of hazardous materials and set up recycling stations for paper, plastic, and metal waste.
- Consider how art can support ecological balance and community well-being.

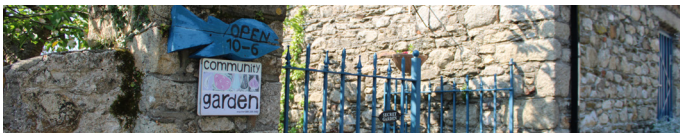

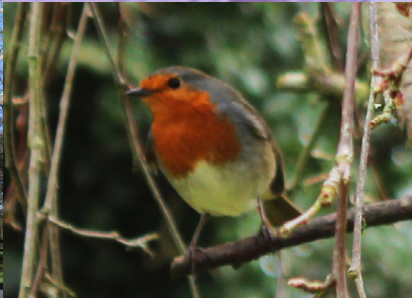
