A submission or observation in relation to the application may be made in writing to the Planning Authority on payment of the prescribed fee, €20, and accompanied by the relevant declaration within the period of 5 weeks beginning on the date of receipt by the Authority of the application, and such submissions or observations will be considered by the Planning Authority in making a decision on the application. The Planning Authority may grant permission subject to, or without conditions, or may refuse to grant permission.

Directions for completing this notice

1. The name of the Planning Authority to which the planning application will be made should be inserted here

 - (g) where the application is accompanied by an opinion on unconfirmed details an indication of that fact
