Site Location & Description

Aylesbury is a residential development of 50 detached and semi-detached dwellings. The development is accessed via a Roundabout on the R711 (old N25) and the "Aylesbury Road" estate road. Aylesbury Road also provides access to Oak Ridge Housing Estate to the west, Brothers of Charity Lands to the north and "The Crescent" Housing Estate (already in the Council's charge) and the Aldi Shop to the east.

Note: The development currently being considered for taking in charge is part of phase 1 of a much larger housing development originally proposed (in excess of 300 housing units). Planning permission has now lapsed on the site and the developer has gone into receivership. The 50 dwellings now being considered represent the only fully completed section of the originally envisaged development. The remaining portion of Phase 1 immediately to the east of the completed section has already been acquired by Kilkenny County Council with plans for a community park to serve Aylesbury and the wider neighbourhood being progressed.

Planning History

P02/750: Permission granted to Brothers of Charity Services for 327 housing units granted on

15" May 2003, subject to 32 conditions. The development was split into 4 phases.

P05/1249: Permission for revisions to Phase I of the development as authorised under P02/750

granted to Richmond Partnership on 25th October 2005 subject to 3 conditions.

Application for extension of duration of permission P02/750 granted to Richmond P08/427:

Partnership without conditions on 24th June 2008.

TIC Request:

The formal application to have this development taken in charge was made by the Receiver on behalf of the developer on 19th November 2013. The application was referred to the various internal service areas of the council, and based on the responses a schedule of necessary works was prepared. A claim was made against the development bond with additional funding also secured from the Department of the Environment, Community and Local Government in 2016 under the National Taking in Charge Initiative for Residential Estates. Works were undertaken towards the end of 2016 and in 2017.

Recommendation:

Having regard to the completion of the development in accordance with the conditions attached to the grant of permission and the substantial completion of all works as identified by the various internal service areas I recommend that Kilkenny County Council initiate proceedings for the formal taking in charge of Aylesbury, Ferrybank, Co. Kilkenny, as outlined on the attached map.
