Site Location & Description

Riverside Park is a residential development of 30 semi-detached dwellings. The development is accessed from the Gortnahoo Road (R639) via Togher Lawns. A second pedestrian only access connects the development to Main Street.

Planning History

P01/1393:

Outline permission for the construction of 30 no. dwellings, granted on 22nd August

2002, following a 3rd party appeal to An Bord Pleanála.

P02/1596:

Permission for the construction of 30 no. dwellings, granted on 4th June 2003.

Commenced in March 2004.

TIC Request:

The formal application to have this development taken in charge was made by a majority of home owners on 14th July 2015. The application was referred to the various internal service areas of the council, and based on the responses a schedule of necessary works was prepared. As the original developer did not engage with the council a claim was made against the development bond. The bondholder subsequently arranged for all works identified to be completed.

Recommendation:

Having regard to the completion of the development in accordance with the conditions attached to the grant of permission and the completion of all works as identified by the various internal service areas, I recommend that Kilkenny County Council initiate proceedings for the formal taking in charge of Riverside Park, Urlingford, Co.
