 - (i) “Notice is hereby given, that at a meeting of the Council to be held after the expiration of 10 days from the date of this notice, it is the intention of Kilkenny County Council, in accordance with the provisions of Section 183 of the Local Government Act, 2001, Kilkenny County Council hereby approves of the Lease of the former Bank of Ireland Premises at Main Street, Urlingford, Co. Kilkenny to Urlingford Town Team CLG, Bia Blasta, Main Street, Urlingford, Via Thurles, Co. Kilkenny, for use as a Remote Working Hub, for a period of 25 years and a nominal rent of €1 per week. Each party will be responsible for their own legal costs associated with the transaction. The Consent of the Minister for Housing, Local Government and Heritage is not required.” (*Notice sent to Members on the 30th June, 2022*).

“I would like to propose the motion that Kilkenny County Council acknowledges that thousands of people are suffering with adverse effects from Covid-19 for long periods of time. Unfortunately, the health supports that are needed for those suffering are not in abundance or widely available with the threat of some services currently in place, being withdrawn.

We propose that Long Covid Multidisciplinary Clinics with upskilled Occupational Therapists for post-COVID care, in both acute hospitals and primary care services, should be available in every county alongside the upskilling of relevant medical practitioners. The Council agrees to write to Minister for Health Stephen Donnelly, the Oireachtas Health Committee and the HSE CEO Paul Reid requesting that the provision of Long Covid Clinics is retained and expanded.

The Council also agrees to raise it with our Regional Health Board and/or local hospital and at any other suitable juncture.”
