






Initial €30m being allocated over 18months for two strands:

Strand 1

Strand 1 Action; Building Low Carbon Communities

€24m

Community Led projects

€511,000 to Kilkenny County Council, Community Action Projects



Strand 1a; Shared Island Community Climate Action €3m

To support cross-border & all Ireland community climate action initiatives Partnership Approach, Clear North/South Basis 50/50 funding
