Dear Councillor,

I enclose details of the applications evaluated and recommended for funding under the 2023 Amenity Grant Scheme.

Budget - The 2023 budget approved for Amenity Grants is €140,000.

Promotion - The Amenity Grant Scheme was advertised in the Kilkenny People Newspaper and on the Council's website on the 25th of January 2023. An application form was also posted out to each of the previous year's applicants. The closing date for applications was the 31st March, 2023.

Applications:

- A total of 180 applications have been received;
- 1 application was ineligible as it did not meet with the objectives of the Amenity Grant Scheme;
- A total of 179 applications are therefore being recommended for approval as per the attached schedule.

Evaluation Committee - the applications were evaluated by the following:

An evaluation of the applications was undertaken with reference to a range of evaluation criteria and category classifications (i.e. 15 categories A – O based on size of town or village, number of houses in the estate, etc). There was a slight decrease in the award under some of the categories due to the slightly higher number of applications this year as compared to 2023 (172).

I recommend the allocations as outlined on the attached schedule in the total amount of €139,880. The small balance remaining will cover some of the cost of advertising the scheme.
