 - 600 units to be delivered in this 3 year period.
 - 100% grant funded.
 - Significant cashflow requirement to fund purchase / construction.
- Fire Services
 - 100% grant funded.
 - Urlingford Cost of €1.7m
 - New Station for Kilkenny City €6m approved.
 - Suitable site to be sourced
 - Equipment ongoing requirement.





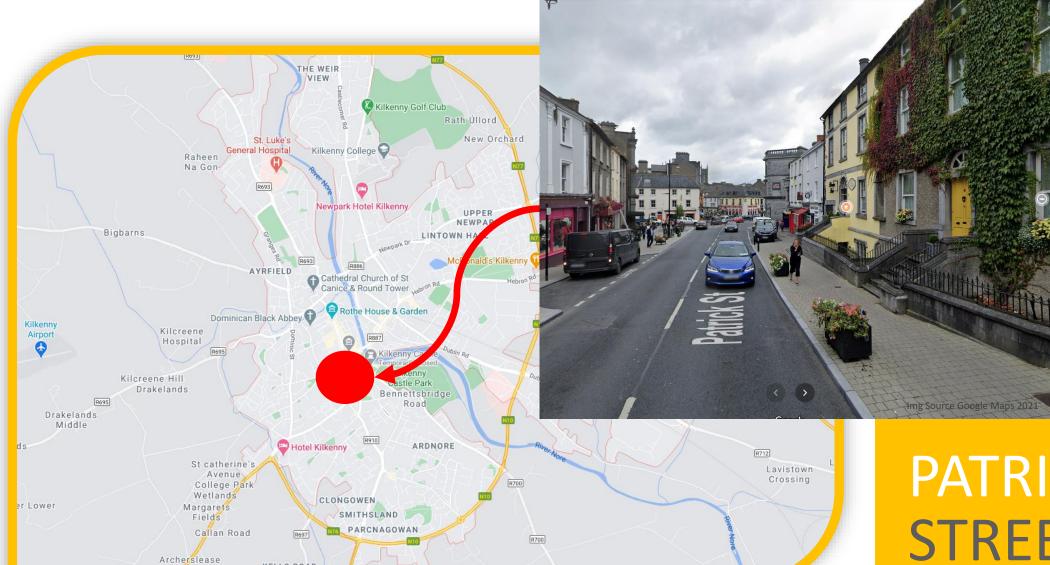

- Development of 2 new secondary schoolsOPP for Primary School.







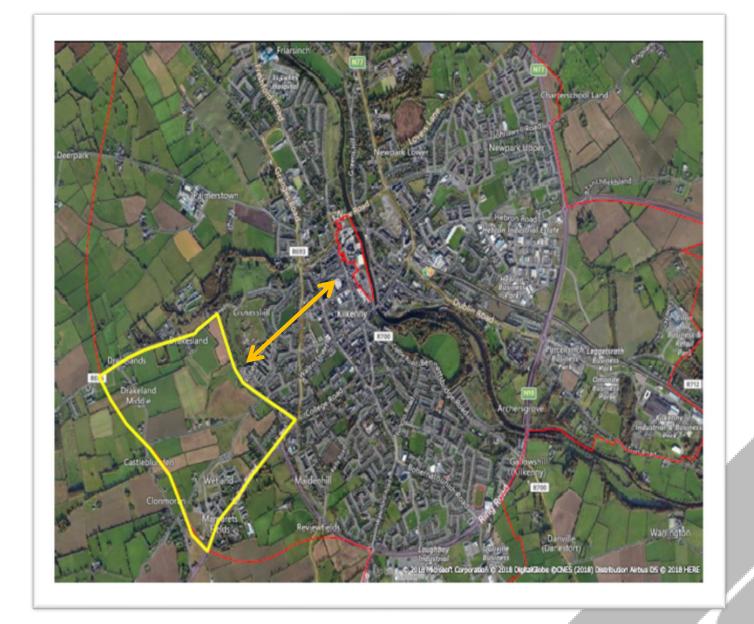




BREAGAGH VALLEY

CAPITAL PROGRAMME – ABBEY QUARTER

Abbey Quarter:

- Site purchase + general spend = €7.5m.
 - €7.1m spent to date.
 - €2.3M Recharged to Abbey Quarter Partnership.
- Balance to be funded of €480k.
- Phase 1: URDF 2019 Funded portion Riverside Park, Brewhouse Public Realm, Mayfair Public realm, Tea Houses, Cultural Hub, Temporary car Park.
 - Total estimated spend = €7.0m, match funding of €1.0m required.
 - Riverside Park complete €2.2m.
 - Horse barrack lane & Brewhouse courtyard complete €2.44m.
 - Tea Houses complete €395k.
 - Temporary car/coach park Complete.
 - Mayfair public realm to be completed with Mayfair library.



CAPITAL PROGRAMME – ABBEY QUARTER

Abbey Quarter:

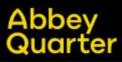
- Phase 2: URDF 2020 Funded portion Urban Street, park, Greensbridge boardwalk, maturation vats.
 - Estimated spend of €17.4m, Grant allocation of €12.9m up from €11.36m.
 - Additional grant funding of €1.6m has been approved.





St. Francis Park & Street

- Planning Permission granted in February 2021
- URDF grant funding awarded subject to final approval form the DHLGH.
- Due to Commence on Site Q1 2023.
- Due for completion Q2 2024.
- Provides access and opens all plots for development

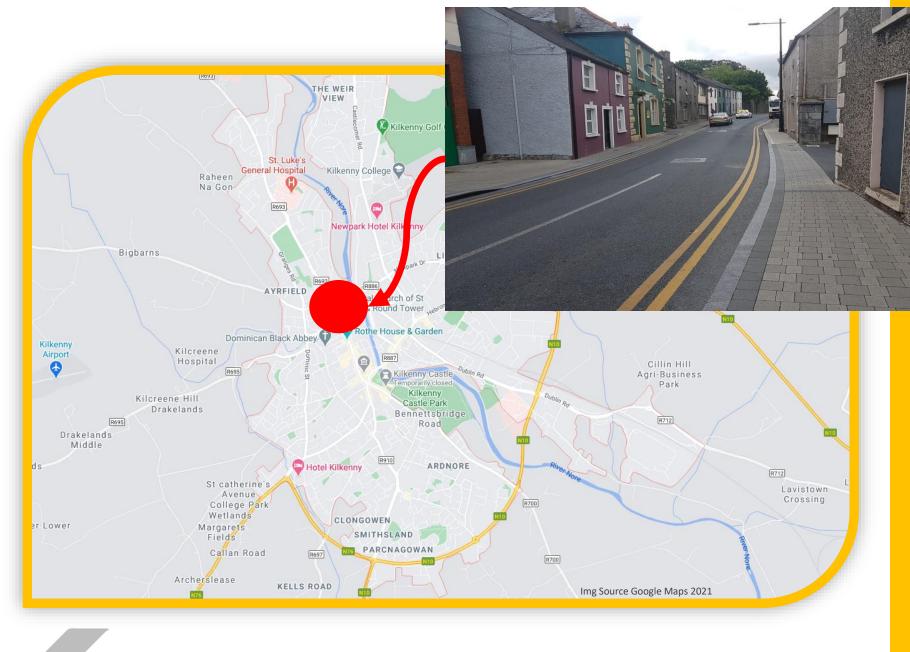

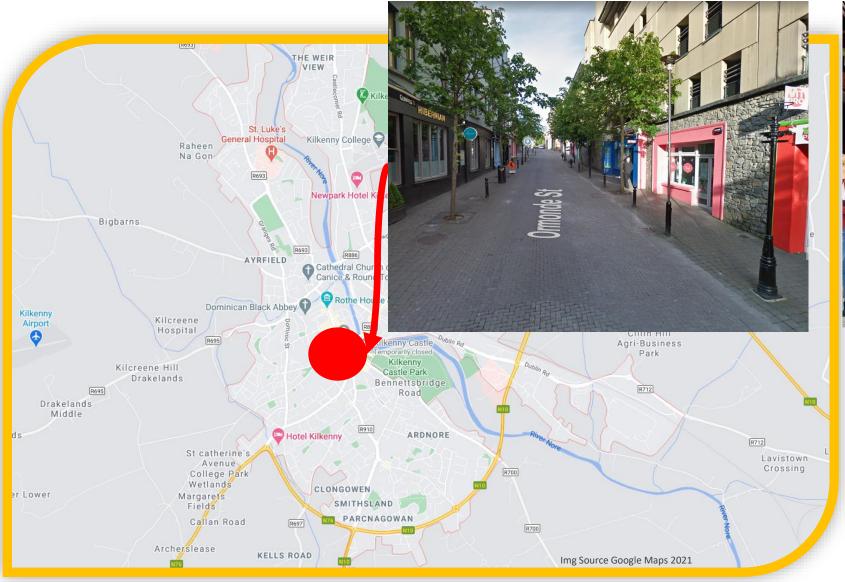

- Kieran St Upgrade Planning approved in December 2022.
 Commence construction in Q3 2023.
- Carneige Plaza & Barrack Lane upgrade Need final Department approval.
- Upgrade St Mary's Precinct.
- Total Estimated spend of €8.9m.
 - match funding of €1.8m required.
- Additional grant funding may be required.

- Funding in place.
- Works ongoing, complete by the end of May 2023.

CAPITAL PROGRAMME – URDF FERRYBANK

- URDF 2019 Ferrybank:
 - Belmont Link Road.
 - Port Road.
 - Abbey Road Greenway connectivity .
 - Abbey Road & Belmont Road.
- Total Estimated spend of €17.97m up from €13.8m.
 - Match funding of €7.6m required.
 - Additional funding of at least €3.0m to be applied for.



CAPITAL PROGRAMME

City Library:

- Estimated cost of €7.4m.
- Works ongoing.
- Match funding of €800k.
- Additional grant income secured in 2021.

• City Hall:

- Estimated cost of €5.7m.
- Match funding of €1.9m.

Public Lighting Energy Efficiency – Eastern Region:

- KCC is lead authority for 9 counties, Contract value €38m.
- Estimated cost of €3.5m for KCC, No grant funding available.
- Contract has commenced.
- Loan facility of €3.5m approved by the Elected Members.
 - Repayment provided for in the 2023 budget.





THE MAYFAIR

- The Mayfair will be converted into a modern public library
- Works ongoing.

 Construction to be completed by Q2 2023.

CAPITAL PROGRAMME 2023-2025

- Total estimated spend = €163.9m.
- Match funding required = €43.5m.
- Provision needs to be made for cost inflation.
 - Estimates only available at this stage for many of the bigger projects Urban Street/Park, Ferrybank Projects, Breagagh Valley Link.

Funding Available

BORROWINGS - KCC

- Term Loan of €13.5m drawn down in late 2016.
 - Annual cost of €800k.
- Term loan of €5m drawn down in 2020.
 - Repayments of €300k provided for in the 2021 Budget.
- Term loan of €5m approved by Members at December 2019 meeting.
 - Not drawn down yet.
 - Repayments provided for in the 2023 Budget
- Total non mortgage debt drawn at the end of 2022 €18.5m
- Outstanding Commitments on completed capital projects
 - €10m.
 - Annual cost of €2.0m.



CAPITAL PROGRAMME

- Funding shortfall to be addressed.
- Council must have identifiable funding source for each project.
- Current estimate of funding shortfall = €16.5m minimum.
- Opportunities for additional grant funding to be explored:

Breaghagh Valley €4.0m.

• Civil Defence Building €1.9m.

• URDF Projects – Ferrybank €3.1m.

• Thomastown Library €1.2m.
