The bodies of these five members of the Irish National Invincibles lie beneath the paving slabs of the yard where they were executed in 1883 for their part in the Phoenix Park assassinations. The families of the five men are represented by the National Graves Association and the wish of the families is for their relatives remains to be exhumed from Kilmainham jail and reinterred in consecrated ground at Glasnevin cemetery."
