Dear All,

The Naming of Infrastructure Committee was established in 2016 to research and appropriately name new infrastructure in the County and City. The committee is made up of 5 Elected Members and a Chair was selected for the term of the Council. The Members are Cllr. John Coonan (Chair), Cllr. Pat Fitzpatrick , Cllr. Andrew McGuinness, Cllr. Michael Doyle and Cllr. Pat Dunphy.

The Committee is assisted by Corporate Services and a sub-committee consisting of the Heritage Officer, Conservation Officer, Architect, Arts Officer with the support of the Library Local Studies. The sub-committee carry out ground research in relation to the area in order to support appropriate names for the infrastructure.

There are presently five separate pieces of infrastructure to be named in Kilkenny City and Castlecomer as highlighted on the attached map.

The attached report by the sub-committee details the historic context of the names in the area and is the final recommendation agreed by the Naming of Infrastructure Committee. The names are as follows:
