BACKGROUND

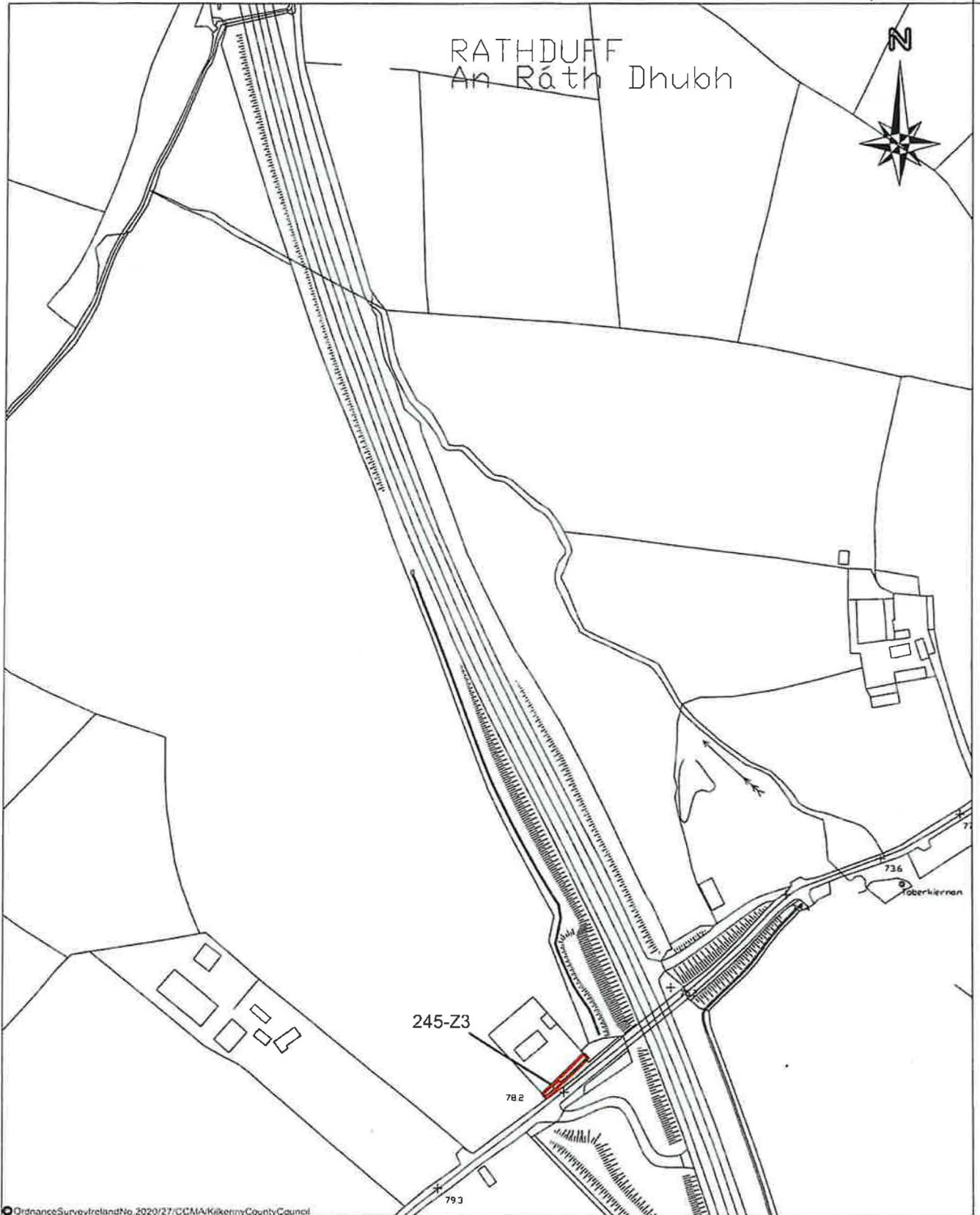

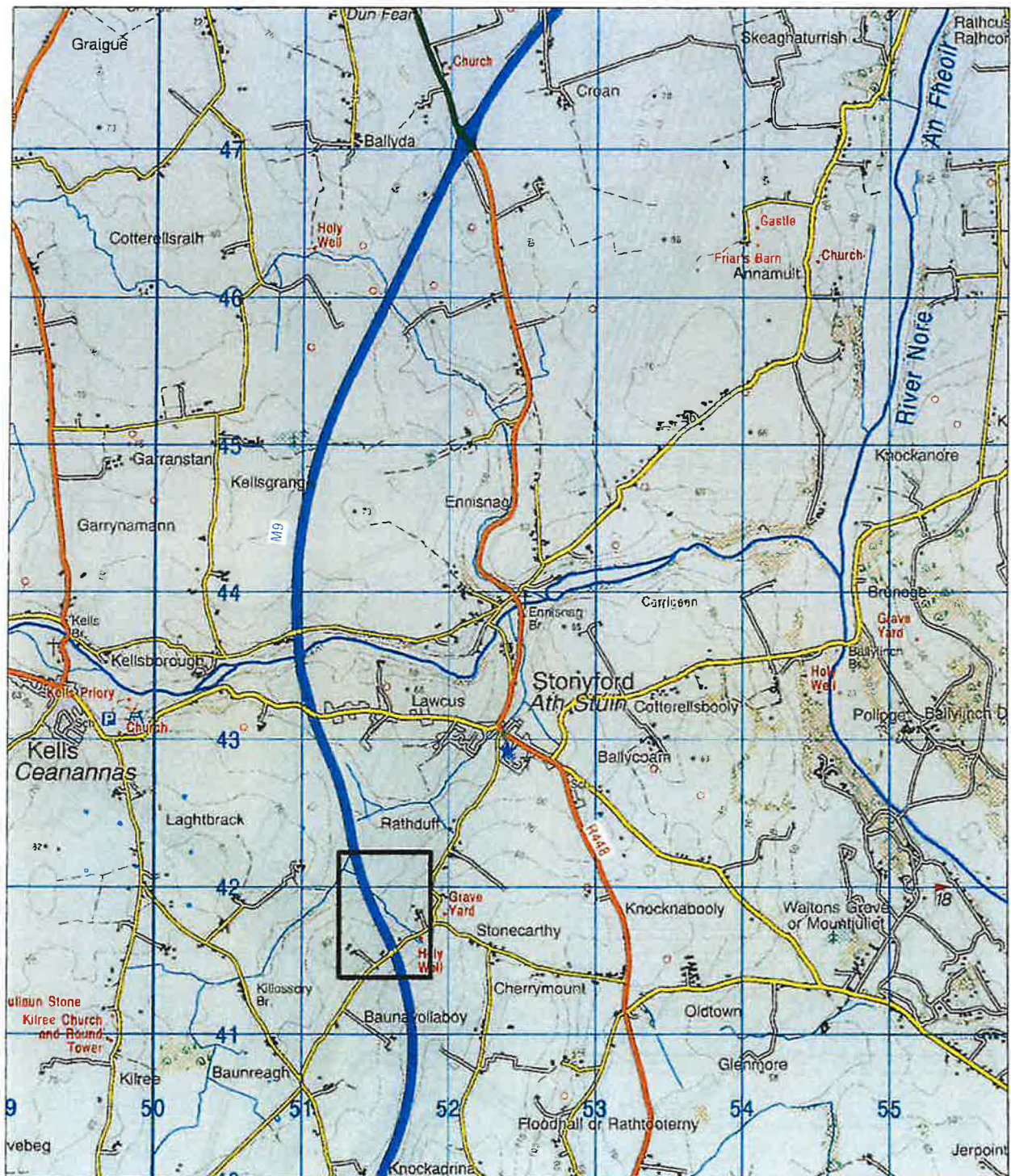
