Notice is hereby given, that at a meeting of the Council to be held after the expiration of 10 days from the date of this notice, it is the intention of Kilkenny County Council, in accordance with Section 183 of the Local Government Act, 2001, to dispose of its interest in a property at Urlingford, Co. Kilkenny – as identified on the attached map - to Health Services Executive HSE – South, Lacken, Dublin Road, Kilkenny for the sum of €115,000. The site extends to circa 650 sq.m (0.16 acres) and the floor area of the building extends to circa 117.62 sq. m.

The Consent of the Minister for Housing, Local Government and Heritage is not required.

BACKGROUND

Following the development of the new Fire Station in Urlingford, the old Fire Station is now vacant. HSE – South contacted Kilkenny County Council to express an interest in purchasing the former Fire Station as a Deployment Station for the National Ambulance Service. The site extends to circa 650 sq.m (0.16 acres) and the floor area of the building extends to circa 117.62 sq. m.

A Valuation was completed by the Valuation Office and a sum of €115,000 was agreed. Both parties will be responsible for their own legal fees in this matter.

The sale is subject to the requirements of **DPER Circular 11/15 – Protocols for the Transfer and Sharing of State Property Assets.**
