"That this Council calls on the Minister for Climate, Environment and Energy, Minister Darragh O'Brien to urgently consider the introduction of a grant scheme to support homeowners in testing their homes for Radon Gas and safeguarding against the impacts. Radon is a colourless, odourless radioactive gas and is recognised as the second leading cause of lung cancer after smoking. Despite its dangers, its presence is entirely preventable through proper testing and mitigation.

Given the serious public health risks associated with prolonged exposure, it is essential that the Department provides financial assistance to encourage widespread testing.

We urge the Minister to respond positively and act swiftly in making such supports available to homeowners."
