Notice is hereby given, that at a meeting of the Council to be held after the expiration of 10 days from the date of this notice, it is the intention of Kilkenny County Council, in accordance with Section 183 of the Local Government Act, 2001, to dispose of its interest in land at Coolmore, Knocktopher, Co. Kilkenny Plot 206z.2 – as identified on the attached map - to William Coogan, Ballynooney, Mullinavat, Co. Kilkenny and Mairead Coogan, Cappagh House, Cappagh, Inistioge, Co. Kilkenny.

The Consent of the Minister for Housing, Local Government and Heritage is not required.

BACKGROUND

This land was acquired as part of the M9 Motorway Scheme but was not required for the permanent works. The land is surplus and has been part of the Coogan's field since the completion of the M9. The land area measures 0.035 ha/0.086 acre.


Transport Infrastructure Ireland have approved this transaction.

William and Mairead Coogan are responsible for legal fees associated with this transfer for both themselves and Kilkenny County Council and a nominal sum of €10 consideration for the land.


