

## **Minutes of Meeting**

**1. Minutes of last meeting on Wednesday 19<sup>th</sup> March, 2025**

Minutes were proposed by Cllr. Michael McCarthy, seconded by Cllr. Pat Dunphy and agreed.

**2. Matters arising**

Fergus Canton enquired about the proposed establishment of an Irish Language group within Kilkenny County Council. The matter will be followed up with Margo Hayes, Corporate Section.

**3. Creative Ireland Presentation**

Majella Keating, Creative Communities Engagement Officer gave a presentation on the overview of the Creative Ireland programme, highlighting its priorities and funded projects and the grants scheme. Majella provided information on Cruinníu na nÓg held on 7<sup>th</sup> June 2025 where 52 events were planned across Kilkenny. There was a total of 39 groups/organisations approved for funding under the Creative Ireland Grant scheme for 2025. Part of the presentation included a video showcasing the 'Living Artfully' health and wellbeing project, delivered in collaboration with Carlow County Council and featuring creative workshops such as painting, pottery, and singing. The video included positive feedback from the artists and participants.

Mary Dolan shared details of a Cois Nore project funded by Creative Ireland, where children created artwork for display near the therapy room, offering comfort to children.

Future projects were discussed, including involvement in next year's St. Patrick's Day parade. The presentation and Creative Ireland programme received positive feedback from all members, with Cllr. Tomás Breathnach praising Kilkenny County Council's strong community connections, and Cllr. John Brennan highlighting the programme's wide-reaching benefits.

#### **4. Healthy Ireland Presentation**

Janette Boran, Healthy Ireland Coordinator for Kilkenny County Council gave a presentation on the Healthy Ireland programme. Janette outlined the programme's focus on enhancing physical activity and self-perceived health among disadvantaged and priority groups. Key initiatives include youth activity programmes, social farming, adapted cycling, and health needs analyses in Eastern Environs. Janette highlighted recent campaigns such as 'Not Around Us'—a smoking and vaping prevention initiative. Janette informed the members about the UcanACT project, a pilot project promoting physical activity for older adults as a cancer prevention tool, co-funded by the EU. Janette Boran will present the UcanACT project at the EU Parliament in Brussels on 11<sup>th</sup> June 2025.

Janette thanked Mary Dolan for her support with Cois Nore in getting individuals to take part in the UcanACT project. The group extended their best wishes to Janette for her upcoming presentation in Brussels.
